EUROPEAN JUDICIAL CYBERCRIME NETWORK

- The Network is composed of Contact Points
- Appointed by EU Member States and Observers
- Meets at least twice per year in Plenary Sessions
- Two year long work programs
- The Board manages the Network, prepares its decisions and oversees their implementation

Goals of EJCN



- ▶ Provide access and disseminate information on cybercrime
- ▶ Provide a forum for discussions of practical and legal problems
- ▶ Exchange information on domestic legislation, relevant case law, international cooperation and best practices
- ▶ Promote the use of Eurojust in cross-border cases

- Develop expertise and knowledge on specific topics
- Contribute to activities of relevant stakeholders
- Training and capacity building of judicial authorities
- Development of a website with relevant information for practitioners
