

This report sheds light on the current situation of digital evidence in the Union, as there is a need for digital data in most criminal investigations.



EJN, the report brings together perspectives from law enforcement, judicial authorities and Online Service Providers.



The report shows an increase in the satisfaction of officers with the existing cross-border data request process yet with many challenges to be addressed.

EU Judicial Authorities

- Promote initiatives to develop a clearer overview on the different national processes in place
- Strengthen the interconnection and knowledge exchange among EU judicial practitioners

EU Law Enforcement

- Use SIRIUS to provide periodic training on crossborder requests to Online Service Providers
- Establish Single
 Points of Contact for electronic evidence

- Disseminate updates about policies and changes in processes to EU authorities, also through SIRIUS
- Publish periodic transparency reports regarding requests from EU authorities with standardised data categories
