Background information

EuroMed Justice Programme

EuroMed Justice (EMJ) is a capacity-building programme designed to develop a sustainable cross-regional mechanism of judicial cooperation in criminal matters between EU Member States (EU MS), the South Partner Countries (SPCs) – Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine* and Tunisia – and EU JHA Agencies. The main purpose of the programme is to strengthen international cooperation in criminal matters between SPCs and EU MSs and EU JHA Agencies.

Working languages

Simultaneous or consecutive interpretation in **Arabic and English** will be assured during the Study Visit.

Objectives of the Study Visit

The objective of the study visit is to familiarise high representatives from the central judicial authorities of South Partner Countries with general information regarding the EU rule of law and justice system and the role, organisation and functioning of the Court of Justice of European Union, European Public Prosecutor's Office, Luxembourgish General Prosecutor's Office and the Academy of European Law.
